

MOROCCANS OF THE WORLD, FOREIGN TOURISTS VISITING MOROCCO

New measures relating to the temporary admission (TA) mode of transport means come into effect on May 1st, 2014.

As from this date, the motor vehicles of private use transporting goods in commercial quantities are not allowed any more in Morocco under the TA mode ("D16 bis" and "D16Ter" declarations will not be delivered any more).

The importation of goods for commercial purposes will have to comply with the import regulations and current procedures.

By adopting this new measure, the legislator intended :

- to fight informal trade and tax avoidance
- to strengthen the security of the country by delimiting illicit trafficking
- to protect the environment and citizens' health

The vehicles for private use, as well as their spare parts, their accessories and normal equipment, which you import for your strictly personal use as a permanent resident abroad, continue to benefit from the TA mode for the duration of your stay in Morocco, provided that this period does not exceed six months for private cars and three months for commercial vehicles (vans, small vans, etc.).
